

WINTER ECLECTIC – RULES AND PROCEDURE 2025/26

- 1. You can submit a maximum of 10 cards per course. Your first card submitted is a base card and the object is to improve your score at every hole with subsequent cards submitted.**
- 2. Handicaps will be applied at an adjustment of 50% of course handicap at the date of submission of your base card.**
- 3. You don't have to inform us of your intention to submit a card prior to playing and you don't have to submit your card if you don't want to.**
- 4. Cards must be signed by your playing partner and mailed to stationmasters@live.co.uk asap after playing. A score recorded only for the hole/s you have improved on, is sufficient. Running totals will be updated by us every week and posted on the website.**
- 5. The Burnside Course is undergoing extensive irrigation works over the winter and it's inevitable that various holes will be closed or altered. You must therefore play the course as you find it and accept that you may not have the opportunity to record a score on the same hole/s layout as other competitors have throughout the winter.**
